

Spotlight: Growing Independence

As our children move into the second half of the school year, we are going to nurture their independence even more. We will support them as they learn self-help skills like putting on coats, managing belongings, and trying tasks before asking for help. Research shows that these small moments of independence build confidence, problem-solving skills, and a strong sense of competence in young children (Child Mind Institute, 2023)

At home, simple choices ("Do you want the blue hat or the red hat?") or encouraging "You try first!" help children feel proud and capable.
