Spotlight: Supporting Potty Learning

Learning to use the potty is an important developmental milestone. The American Academy of Pediatrics explains that children are most successful with toilet learning when adults follow readiness cues and provide consistent, pressure-free routines. In our preschool classrooms, teachers support this process through encouragement, predictable routines, and positive language. The National Association for the Education of Young Children also emphasizes that developmentally appropriate practices and strong home-school partnerships help children build confidence and independence during this stage.
